Bowden Scholarship Fund provides youth disciples of Mount Hope Baptist Church financial assistance, as they further their education at a university, college, or an accredited trade school on a full-time basis.

If you are interested in applying for this scholarship, please review and follow the guidelines and instructions enclosed. A completed application MUST be submitted or postmarked by the applicable deadline date of May 31, 2021 for high school seniors and June 30, 2021 or college students. All completed applications must be submitted to the church office during work hours or via the U.S. Mail. Submitting early is encouraged! Note: Please do not give applications to ushers, church officers, or scholarship committee members during Sunday church services.

The topics for this year's essay are: (Select one)

- (1) How has your Christian faith influenced your educational goals and life plans?
- (2) Name a person who has significantly influenced your life and explain how their influence has impacted your educational goals and life plans?

Essays must be 300 words in length for high school seniors and 500 words for college students. All essays must be typed, double-spaced, and in 12 pitch font. Grammar, organization, and presentation of your essay will be closely evaluated by the committee.

Scholarship Ministry Guidelines

Purpose: The Linda A. Bowden Scholarship Fund was established to assist the <u>youth</u> disciples of Mt Hope Baptist Church in furthering their <u>undergraduate</u> studies.

- 1. Recipient *MUST* be a <u>disciple</u> of Mt Hope Baptist Church. (Six month minimum prior to application's deadline) One or both Parents or Guardians need to be disciples in good standing (regular attendance, record of giving, and participation in one or more ministries). Regular attendees who are not disciples are ineligible.
- 2. Recipient must be a regular attendee when possible or have participated in at least one of Mount Hope Baptist Church's ministries. For the Class of 2020 high school graduates, there needs to be at least one year of documented participation in ministry of the applicant as verified by a letter from our youth minister Rev. Maurice Bowles, III or from an adult member of The Standard ministry.
- 3. Scholarship maximum eligibility is determined annually. This year's maximum is 4 years. Recipient must be a full-time student within 1 year of graduating high school to be eligible. Failure to comply will result in your ineligibility for future scholarships.
- 4. Recipient must be enrolled or accepted to a college, university or an accredited trade school on a **full time** basis (12 credits minimum). Proof of enrollment is required before receiving scholarship.
- 5. Recipient must be working towards an associate's degree, <u>undergraduate</u> degree or a certificate of completion.
- 6. Submit an assigned essay: (topic to be assigned)
 High School Senior 300 words --- Returning College Students 500 words

After students receive the scholarship for the first time, college students must renew annually by completing a new application.

- 7. High School Senior GPA waived **Must have letter of acceptance** College Student must have a <u>2.0</u> or higher GPA.
- 8. Deadline for submission: High school senior is *May 31, 2021*

College returning students: June 20, 2021

(Applications will not be accepted after posted deadline)

- 9. Submit *two <u>new</u>* letters of reference from any of the following: **teacher**, **counselor**, **principal**, **professor**, **advisor**, **or** a **community leader** verifying your services. **One <u>must</u>** be from a church ministry here or from one you are participating with in your school area. Community based organization recommendation are acceptable. (Letters from family members will not be accepted.) Letters should be on letterhead (if possible) and <u>must be signed by the recommender</u>. Letters should not be written by the staff of Mt. Hope unless they are also presiding over a ministry.
- 10. Submit copy of <u>entire</u> transcript: official or unofficial (For high school seniors, the 1st semester of senior year should be included)
- 11. Submit completed package to: Mt. Hope Baptist Church, **Attn: Scholarship Committee**, 6823 Harrison Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407.

- 12. Awards will be made payable to the qualifying recipient and/or the parent(s) prior to beginning of classes for that academic school year.
- 13. A color or black/white photograph of the applicant should be submitted.
- 14. For the 2019 high school applicants, a face-to-face meeting is required after the application is submitted. This will allow the scholarship committee members to get to know the applicants.
- 15. The Scholarship Committee will notify qualifying recipients in writing of the committee's decision.
- 16. The Pastor gives the final approval for a scholarship recipient.
- 17. An official presentation will be conducted during the Senior Class Award Ceremony at various high schools for High School graduates. College students will be presented at a presentation ceremony at Mt. Hope Baptist Church.
